

COMAN TIE-BREAKER



OVERVIEW

<i>Definition</i>	The Coman Tiebreak procedure is identical to the regular tiebreak procedure except that the players change ends after the first point and then after every four points until the conclusion of a tiebreak. The Coman Tiebreak procedure is used for all tiebreaks played during a match.
<i>Set Tie-Break</i>	First to win 7 points by 2 points wins “Game “and “Set”
<i>3rd set Match Tie Break (USTA)</i>	First to win 10 points by 2, wins match.
<i>Who serves first?</i>	The player whose turn it is to serve shall serve the first point from the deuce court.
<i>After the first point</i>	<p>The players shall change ends and the following two points shall be served by the opponent(s) (in doubles, the player of the opposing team due to serve next) starting from the ad court.</p> <p>After this, each player/team shall serve alternately for two consecutive points (starting from the ad court); changing ends after every four points, until the completion of the tie break game.</p>
<i>Switch ends</i>	Switch ends after points 1,5,9,13, 17..... and at the conclusion.
<i>Summary</i>	<p>Start with 1st point service from deuce side</p> <p>Then switch sides every 4 points thereafter serving from the ad side</p> <p>Each player serves on the side they serve from during the set</p>
